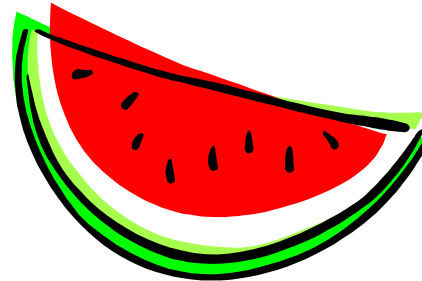
From Sherry's Desk...

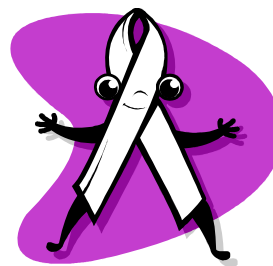
